

## **NightChurch Worship Leader: Role Description**

### **Definition:**

*“An effective corporate worship leader, aided and led by the Holy Spirit, skillfully combines biblical truth with music to magnify the worth of God and the redemptive work of Jesus Christ, thereby motivating the gathered church to join [them] in proclaiming and cherishing the truth about God and seeking to live all of life for the glory of God.” [Bob Kauflin]*

### **Core Values:**

- Love God with all your heart, soul, mind and strength, and love your neighbour as yourself. (Mk 12:30-31)
- Live a life of worship to God which overflows into leading others worship. (Rom 12:1-2)

### **Key Responsibilities:**

- Be a regular attender and active participant of Kew Baptist Church, especially NightChurch.
- Lead music at NightChurch services, for which you are expected to:
  - Be in prayer for the service, seeking God’s guidance in your organisation and entrusting your plans to Him.
  - Communicate with the preacher and service leader regarding the theme and structure for the service.
  - Choose songs for the service, using the Elvanto song database. (New songs can be added in consultation with the Worship Coordinator).
  - Contact musicians to play in your team, being mindful of who has played recently, and provide them with service details (i.e. set list, chord charts, rehearsal time).
  - Lead the rehearsal on Sunday afternoon, including a time of prayer with your team.
  - Lead the time(s) of worship in song during the service, incorporating scripture reading and prayer in your leadership of the congregation. Be prepared to be flexible (e.g. time constraints might result in songs being cut) and be sensitive to the leading of the Holy Spirit during the service, particularly in sensing the spiritual needs of the congregation in the moment (e.g. extending an instrumental to give space for people to pray).
- Work together with the Worship Coordinator and Worship & Prayer Team to develop vision and goals for the worship ministry, and creative input for worship services.

### **Time Investment:**

- Lead music at NightChurch services, in regular rotation with the other worship leaders.
- Attend fortnightly Worship Jams (2nd and 4th Thursdays of each month), and take leading roles in the sessions as directed by the Worship Coordinator.
- Meet quarterly with the Worship & Prayer Team to plan and review our Sunday gatherings.

### **Kew Baptist Church’s Commitment to You:**

- Support, encouragement and prayer for you and your ministry in worship leading.
- Provide you with opportunities to lead and develop this ministry and your gifts.
- Provide oversight, encouragement and feedback to help you grow.
- Value your ministry and contribution as a vital and important aspect of our church’s overall ministry and mission.

### **Length of Term:**

12 months, then reviewed by Worship Coordinator and Senior Pastor for the following year.
