How do I book a venue?

Contact the Kew Baptist Church (KBC) office (admin@kewbaptist.org.au) to check availability for your preferred date. Bookings are on a "first come, first served" basis, except in exceptional circumstances. Scheduling conflicts are resolved at the discretion of the church administrator and/or Pastor.

How soon can I book a venue?

You can book as early as you like. Your booking is confirmed once the date is agreed upon, deposit is paid, and Facility Hire agreement is signed and returned to KBC.

Will KBC provide a quote for hire?

Yes, we can provide a formal hire quote upon request.

I'm getting married! Do you have a centre aisle?

The Chapel features dual side aisles with no central aisle, as commonly featured within Baptist Churches. This can create a unique and elegant layout, and many photographers find it suitable for capturing key moments. Photographers are welcome to visit the venue or attend rehearsals to plan their shots.

Do I need insurance?

Yes, all events must be insured, including public liability coverage. The church's insurance may cover private family functions, but other groups must provide their own public liability insurance. Contact Church Administrator for further information

Frequently Asked Questions

Who provides additional staff? The hirer is responsible for arra

The hirer is responsible for arranging staff. KBC may provide a Minister and AV support for weddings or funerals, subject to availability. A fee may apply.

Can a pastor from another church perform our wedding ceremony?

Yes, clergy from recognized denominations with valid credentials are welcome to officiate. They should use their own marriage documentation and forms.

Can I decorate the venue/s?

Yes, you may decorate the venue. However, as it is a Heritage-listed building, some restrictions may apply. Decorations must be removed after your event, and any displaced items must be returned to their original locations.

Can I use candles, fire, or special effects?

Candles are permitted, but you will be charged for any wax-related cleaning. Fires are not permitted and special effects are at the discretion of KBC.

Is there a kitchen?

- A small kitchen is available adjoining the Newnham Hall. There are no kitchen facilities within the Chapel.
- 11 Can I provide my own catering?
 Yes, you are welcome to provide your own catering.
- 12 Is the venue wheelchair accessible?
 Yes, both the Chapel and Newnham Hall are wheelchair accessible.

Am I responsible for cleaning the venue after my event?

Yes, you are responsible for leaving the venue clean and tidy. Cleaning supplies are available, and bins are provided. Large amounts of rubbish may need to be taken with you.

I would like to hire the hall for a conference. Are there any local accommodation for interstate or overseas participants?

- 15 Can I smoke?

 No, smoking, vaping and use of nonprescription drugs are not permitted
 anywhere on the premises, including the
 Highbury Common playground area.
- 16 Po you have parking?
 Yes, there is a small car park next to the Chapel with space for approximately 10 cars. Street parking is available on Highbury Grove with a 2-hour limit.
- How late can I have the venue?
 Please contact the KBC office to discuss restrictions relating to events held in the evenings.
- 18 Can I sell/serve alcoholic drinks?
 The sale of alcohol is strictly prohibited.
 Consumption of alcohol is generally not allowed; however, you may contact the office to apply for an exemption.
- Can I leave valuable items on site?
 Leaving valuable items unattended is done at your own risk. Consider this when arranging your insurance coverage.
- How long can I hire the venue for?
 You can hire the venue for a wide range of time periods, including long-term and ongoing arrangements. Please contact the KBC office to discuss your specific requirements.
- How do I cancel my booking?

 To cancel your booking, please email admin@kewbaptist.org.au or call 03 9855 0070. Cancellations made within 7 days of the event may still incur the full quoted fee.

Kew Baptist Church is located just 20 minutes from Melbourne CBD and is accessible by tram, bus, and train.

Trams: 16, 48, 109

Buses: 200, 201, 205 (to Kew Junction), 207 (via High Street Kew)

Trains: Belgrave, Lilydale, or Alamein lines to Glenferrie Station (then a 10-minute tram ride)

Walk: 10-15 minute walk from Kew Junction, 2-3 minute walk from Cotham Rd / Glenferrie Rd
